### **Road Projects This Year**

### 2023

Taliesin Way will be reconstructed this year. Wood Haven Estate will also be completing their portion of the road. The town will be receiving \$28,000 from the Local Road Improvement Program.

### 2024

The town received an 80 percent grant (\$313,120) to rebuild Gusman Road. This grand is Federal dollars that we received through the urban funds. This will not be completed until the year 2024. R C Pavers will be repairing Gusman Road and Kersten Road this summer.

Future road repairs to rebuild are Kersten Road, East Gusman, and Ross Ave.

### **Broadband Installation in the Town**

We have been trying to get high speed internet in the town for the last 10 plus years. The state gave Frontier a \$500,000 grant in 2015, to put fiber on Ross Ave. in the town, but they were still only using copper to the house because there were no standards as to what speed they needed to deliver. It was better than what we had but not very fast.

Bug Tussel has been installing fiber Conduent all winter. All the orange tubing that is sticking out of the ground are the main lines. They will be putting green lines to the houses this summer along with fixing the landscaping in the ditch lines. They will be installing the fiber this summer. The new speeds should be close to 100 Mbps. The Town Board has authorized \$40,000 of the ARPA fund to get fiber on Clearview, but I have not gotten Bud Tussel to commit to doing this currently. I am continuing to communicate with them.

**Frontier Communication** will be installing fiber from Wausau along Townline Road, Skyline, Hawthorne Ln, Glenview, Cloverbelt Rd, Popular Ln, Fust Ln, Ross Ave and Kersten Rd. This should be all the roads that intersect with Townline Road. You can look forward to this construction in the summer of 2024.

### **Speed Test**

Many communities that need broadband funding may miss out because the data showing their need is not available. North Central Regional Planning Commission in partnering with Marathon County to help update the information used to award these grants. We need your input to take the speed test today. Encourage your friends and neighbors and co-workers to do the speed test often at different times of the day.

### Village & Town Shred Day

On Wednesday May 10th you can have any confidential paperwork securely shredded. Shredding services will be provided by IROW. IROW is the only NAID AAA Certified Document Destruction Provider in the area. This event is free and open to Town of Weston residents. There is a limit of 5 boxes (or up to 100 lbs. total.) of shredding per vehicle. Items they will shred are, old bills, credit card statements, bank statements legal papers, income tax files, medical records, and financial records. # Exterior Storage Section 94.12.06

- 3. Motor Vehicle Storage. Except in agricultural zoning districts, storage of operable and licensed motor vehicles shall be on a hard or gravel surface. No motor vehicle in any zoning district shall be stored within the minimum hard or gravel surface setbacks of Article 5. All motor vehicle storage areas shall be landscaped in accordance with Article 11. Storage or parking of semi-trailers, buses, and heavy-duty trucks on property zoned or used for residential purposes is prohibited.
- 4. Inoperable Vehicles and Junk. The outside storage of inoperable or unlicensed vehicles, appliances, and other junk or trash shall be prohibited, except as described within the "Junkyard or Salvage Yard" and "Outdoor and Vehicle Repair and Maintenance" land use performance standards and for those uses approved in accordance with the requirements of this Chapter. The storage of inoperable vehicles in association with said uses shall be on a hard or gravel surface meeting applicable hard or gravel surface setback requirements.

### **The Marathon County Alert System**

It has been six years since the shootings that occurred in Rothschild, Schofield, and Weston on March 22, 2017, that took the lives of four Marathon County residents including an Everest Metro Police Officer. Residents are encouraged to register for county alerts. You



can receive these alerts by visiting www.marathoncountysheriff. org and clicking on the Marathon County Alerts logo.

### **Refuse & Recycling**

You should have received your 2023 Refuse & Recycling Guide, which we ask that you keep as a reference for the entire 2023 year.
